



STATE CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS LIST

ANITA JEFFERSON CONLEY RECOGNITION OF EXCELLENCE AWARD

Any teams entering at least one team routine are eligible for this special award. In the spirit of Danceline's founder, we have created an award that is not based solely on dance ability and an award that you, the director, choose.

Please select one member who has proven to possess attributes of integrity, hard work and extra dedication to your team this season. In other words, someone you consider your most admirable member. He or she will be recognized at the award ceremony with a special award.

This is optional, please let us know if you do not want to recognize any of your members. To participate in this award event, complete the appropriate space on the registration form.

SOLO AWARDS

All solos will receive a medal or blue, red or white ribbon. All solos receiving a Division I rating will receive a Division I rating ribbon or medal. The top scoring solos in each age division will receive trophies providing there are at least five contestants in varied divisions.

MISS DANCELINE USA

Only high school and collegiate solo participants are eligible for the Miss Danceline USA Scholarship award. The overall winner of the solo competition will be awarded a \$150 college scholarship!

DIVISION I DUET & ENSEMBLE AWARDS

All duet and ensemble competitors receiving an average score of 90 and above will receive a division I rating ribbon or medal. All Cheer/Dance Squads are eligible for this award.

STUDENT CHOREOGRAPHED ENSEMBLE AWARDS

A first, second and third place plaque or trophy will be awarded for scores 90 and above. Please note if an ensemble is entered under Student Choreography they are not eligible for general ensemble awards.

CONGENIALITY AWARD

Presented to the team demonstrating the most enthusiastic, consistent and authentic support for other performers throughout the competition day.

JUDGES CHOICE AWARD

Each Judge Will Choose One Outstanding Performance To be recognized with this special award.

ENTERTAINER AWARD

Awarded to performing group that demonstrates outstanding audience appeal, energy, and overall enthusiasm in their performance.

COSTUMING AWARD

Awarded to performing group and solos who present unique, innovative and visual effects through their costuming.

DIVISION AWARDS

1st through 3rd place awards will be presented to ensemble and duet groups receiving the highest scores in their division. There must be at least five or more competitors to qualify. 1st through 3rd place awarded based on scores and number of participants. If less than three 1st place only may be awarded.

BEST IN CATEGORY

Awards will be presented to routines receiving the highest scores in their category.

DOUBLE DIVISION I

Trophies awarded to teams and officer groups receiving a Division I rating in 2 categories.

DIVISION I

Trophies awarded to teams and officer groups receiving an average score of 90 or above for a single routine.

SWEEPSTAKES

Trophies awarded to teams and officer groups receiving three or more division I ratings in three separate categories.

DANCELINER GOLD AWARD

Awards to teams and officer groups for team and officer routines receiving three or more judges' averages of 95 or above for three separate routines.

DANCELINER DIRECTOR APPRECIATION AWARD

In the spirit of Danceliner's Leadership Program we are encouraging teams and parents to take the time to acknowledge all the valuable work directors do for our next generation. To be eligible for this award the captain, an officer or parent must complete the appropriate form and submit to the main Danceliner Office at least one week prior to contest.

PRECISION AWARD

Awarded to performing group demonstrating outstanding unison, clarity, and timing throughout performance.

SHOWMANSHIP AWARD

Awarded to performing group that receive highest scores in showmanship.

PRESENTATION AWARD

Awarded to performing group demonstrating outstanding overall effect in performance through areas of staging, choreography, costuming, and other technical areas.

TECHNIQUE AWARD

Awarded to performing group(s) that demonstrate outstanding execution of technical elements in their performances.

CHOREOGRAPHY AWARD

Awarded to performing group(s) that demonstrate unique and innovative choreography in their performances.

DANCELINER STATE GRAND CHAMPION

Awarded to teams and officer groups entered in at least three separate categories who have received the highest average scores for the day. If at least three different groups are competing in various classifications, each classification will receive a State Grand Champion Award. All Grand Champion Winners will receive a \$300 Summer Team Camp Scholarship to the Danceliner Camp of their choice!

DANCELINER STATE RING OF CHAMPIONS

Awarded to the three teams scoring the top three team scores of the day. Eligibility will require entry of at least three different team routines in three separate categories. If more than three team routines are entered the average will be based on the three highest awarded scores. The Ring Of Champions will be given for the first, second and third place overall winners of the entire state contest and be awarded a Gold, Silver and Bronze level trophy. The top three winners will receive a \$1000, \$500, and \$300 Danceliner Camp Scholarship respectfully. Team size and classification will not be a factor in the Ring Of Champions.
