

AWARDS BASED ON NOMINATION

ANITA JEFFERSON CONLEY AWARD OF EXCELLENCE

CHOSEN BY THE DIRECTOR AT TIME OF REGISTRATION

Any teams entering at least **one team routine** are eligible for this special award. In the spirit of Danceline's founder, we offer an award that is chosen by the director. Dancer selected is someone who has proven to possess attributes of integrity, hard work and extra dedication to your team this season. In other words, someone you consider your most admirable member. **This is optional.** Please note your desired candidate must be listed on official registration. These cannot be added later, however the selected name can be changed if necessary if we are given written notice prior to contest.

DIRECTOR APPRECIATION AWARD

CHOSEN BY STAFF BASED ON ESSAY SUBMITTED BY TEAM, PARENT OR BOOSTER CLUB MEMBERS

In the spirit of Danceline's Leadership Program we are encouraging teams and parents to take the time to acknowledge all the valuable work directors do for our next generation. To be eligible for this award the captain, an officer or parent must complete the appropriate form and submit to the main Danceline Office at least one week prior to contest.

AWARDS BASED ON SCORE RECEIVED

SOLO AWARDS -- ALL DIVISIONS

All Soloists will be scored and place in one of these divisions: PLATINUM = Average of 95 or higher SUPERIOR DIVISION I = Average of 90-94 EXCELLENT DIVISION II = Average of 80-89 GOOD DIVISION III = Average of 70-79

If a dancer enters more than one solo, only the top scoring solo will be used for award placement.

DUET, TRIO, ENSEMBLE & SOCIAL OFFICER AWARDS -- ALL DIVISIONS

All routines will be scored and place in one of these divisions:
PLATINUM = Average of 95 or higher
SUPERIOR DIVISION I = Average of 90-94
EXCELLENT DIVISION II = Average of 80-89
GOOD DIVISION III = Average of 70-79

ELITE, TEAM OR OFFICERS

All entries will be scored and can be eligible for one of these awards:

PLATINUM SWEEPSTAKES

Trophies awarded to elite, teams and officer groups receiving and average of 95 or higher in three separate categories. Note that if more than three routines are entered, the top three scores are tallied for this award.

SWEEPSTAKES

Trophies awarded to elite, teams and officer groups receiving three or more division I ratings in three separate categories. Note that if more than three routines are entered, the top three scores are tallied for this award.

DIVISION I

Trophies awarded to elite, teams and officer groups receiving an average score of 90 or above for a single routine.

AWARDS BASED ON PLACEMENT

SOLO AWARDS - BASED ON AGE DIVISION

All solos will be ranked according to their age division. From each age division there will be placement award from 1st-3rd place. If there are not 3 or more competitors in a given age division, the competitor must receive a Division I rating to be awarded 1st Place Solo Winner.

In the Varsity division, there will be Top 5 Soloists that will compete for a final ranking of 1st-3rd place. Solo Finalists who perform again for finals will not receive a scoresheet or video critique for this performance. All soloists who place as a top soloist are eligible to compete at Nationals!

NEW OVERALL SOLO CHAMPION

We are excited to add a new solo award this year to our top performers. At each contest we will choose the top 3 to 5 solo scores from all solos of the day regardless of age division for some special Overall Awards. The number of winners will be based on the amount of solos and scores at the respective contest.

MISS DANCELINE USA SOLO CHAMPION

Only varsity solo participants are eligible for the Miss Danceline USA Scholarship award. The first place winner of the solo competition will be awarded a \$150 college scholarship!

DUET, TRIO, ENSEMBLE & SOCIAL OFFICER AWARDS

All duets, trios, ensembles and social officer routines will be ranked 1st through 3rd place based on scores. If less than three participants in any given category, 1st place only may be awarded if a Division I rating Is received.

AWARDS BASED ON PLACEMENT CONT.

BEST IN CATEGORY

Awards presented to teams and officer groups receiving the highest score in each category for their size and class. If less than 3 entries in a category a team must score a 95 or higher to qualify for this award.

BEST IN CATEGORY CHAMPION

Awarded to the highest score of the day in each category. All teams are compiled together regardless of class, age or size division for this top award. There must be at least three groups in each category to qualify.

DANCELINE GOLD

An exclusive award given to the top three team scores of the day for a single routine from different schools or studios. All teams are compiled together regardless of class, size or age division for this top award. Eligibility will require entry of one team or one officer routine.

A team or officer group is only eligible for one Danceline Gold Award

DANCELINE GRAND CHAMPION - ELITE ADDED

Awarded to elite, teams and officer groups entered in at least three separate categories who have received the highest average scores for the day. If at least three different groups are competing in various classifications, each classification will receive a Grand Champion Award. If less than 3 competitors the score must be 95 or higher.

REGIONAL RING OF CHAMPIONS - OFFICERS ADDED

Awarded to the top 3 teams and top 3 officers with the Highest average score. Team size and classification will not be a factor in the Overall Regional Ring of Champions.

ALL RING OF CHAMPION WINNERS WILL RECEIVE A DANCELINE SUMMER CAMP SCHOLARSHIP IN THE FOLLOWING AMOUNTS:

Ring of Champion Gold Winner = \$500 Scholarship Ring of Champion Silver Winner = \$400 Scholarship Ring of Champion Bronze Winner = \$300 Scholarship

INDIVIDUAL PHOTOGENIC AWARD

First place winners in the photogenic category will receive a special award on contest day. All photogenic candidates will be entered into the overall selection process and the overall winner will receive a \$100 cash prize to be announced to the winner and on our web site and social media sites one month after the conclusion of contest season. For Teams and Officers, If a routine is competing against itself (there are no other teams in the same category) then they must average a 95 or higher to win first place or Grand Champion.

DANCEINE CHOICE AWARDS

JUDGES CHOICE AWARD

Each Judge Will Choose One Outstanding Performance To be recognized as their favorite for this special award. This award Is based on one routine.

SPECIAL JUDGES RECOGNITION AWARDS

CONGENIALITY AWARD

Presented to the team demonstrating the most enthusiastic, consistent and authentic support for other performers throughout the competition day.

PRECISION AWARD

Awarded to the performance demonstrating outstanding unison, clarity, and timing throughout their routine.

TECHNIQUE AWARD

Awarded to the performance that demonstrates outstanding execution of technical elements in their performances.

CHOREOGRAPHY AWARD

Awarded to the performance that demonstrate unique and innovative choreography in their performances.

SHOWMANSHIP AWARD

Awarded to the performance that receive highest scores in showmanship.

ENTERTAINER AWARD

Awarded to the performance that demonstrates outstanding audience appeal, energy, and overall enthusiasm in their performance.

ARTISTIC EXPRESSION AWARD

Awarded to performances that demonstrate outstanding and unique choreography that inspires recognizable emotion their performance.

PRESENTATION AWARD

Awarded to the performance demonstrating outstanding overall effect in performance through areas of staging, choreography, costuming, and other technical areas.
